# INSTALLING the SWStream App

Make sure your Roku TV device is connected to your home internet (Wi-Fi or wired ethernet).


From the Roku home screen, use the arrow buttons on your Roku remote to navigate down the menu options on the left until the **Search** option is highlighted and press **"OK"**

Enter in the channel name **"SW Stream TV"** into the search bar.




Once the **"SW Stream TV"** channel name is entered into the search bar, the channel name will appear on the right. Navigate over to the right until **"SW Stream TV"** is highlighted and press **"OK"**

The **Add app** option will now be highlighted, Press **"OK"** to complete the process.



### Log In:

Enter your **subscriber name and subscriber password** on the login screen.



Record what you're currently watching live, schedule recordings of upcoming shows or series directly from the TV Guide, or even record programs that aired up to 24 hours ago.

- **Access Helpful Tools from the Main Menu:**


Check your local weather, view channels with available restart options, and access Settings to create favorite channel lists or set up parental controls.

- **Replay or Record Past Programs:**

Use the TV Guide to go back up to 24 hours and watch or record previously aired shows—or add them to your favorites for easy access later.



## Options in TV Guide



You can scroll back up to 24 hours in the TV Guide to watch or record any programs you may have missed.


Additionally, the main menu includes a **“Restart TV”** section, where you’ll find a list of all programs from the past 24 hours that are available to restart—organized by channel number.

## While Watching TV

## How to Record Programs:


### 1. Record While Watching Live:

- You can record the program you're currently watching. Choose to record just that episode or the entire series.

### 1. Schedule or Record from the TV Guide:


- Use the TV Guide to schedule a recording for an upcoming program, or scroll back up to 24 hours to watch or record a previously aired show.

**Note:** All recordings are automatically deleted after 7 days.




## SETTINGS

From the **Main Menu**, select **Settings** to display these options.




# CREATING FAVORITES

Create as many favorite channel lists as you want.




## HOW TO SEE YOUR FAVORITE LIST

Select **All Channels** from the main menu to display the left screen view below. After you create favorite channel lists, for example “SPORTS”, you can switch to display your favorite “SPORTS” channel list here. Switch the list by using the remote **left/right arrows**.



# CHANGING YOUR FAVORITE LISTS

While viewing your favorite list, press and hold the **OK** button to display the screen below. You can remove this channel from your favorites list.



While viewing all channels, press and hold the **OK** button to display the screen below. You can **add this channel** to your **favorites** list.
